

## **Minutes - Village Board Meeting Aug 17, 2020**

Pledge to the Flag – open 7:30pm

Mayor Bowman – says date extended to 11/6 for remote meetings.

Trustee Moroney asked when the Workshop was cancelled. He was not notified. Mayor Bowman and Mindy assure him that it won't happen again.

Approval of Vouchers – August - \$1850 for Marc ? Regular monthly payment. Every month we pay the same amount. Cleaning bill was cut off. Trustee Moroney couldn't sign. – all vouchers approved without cleaning one. Trustee Moroney makes motion – Trustee Winward seconds. All in favor.

Approval of minutes - July Board Meeting – minutes – a few changes were made - Trustee Pedlosky makes motion to approve, Trustee Winward – seconds – all in favor.

Correspondence – Letter from Resident Heidi Wendel regarding paving projects and the materials that are being used. Concern about pollution from the projects. Will speak to Polhemus to make sure they keep the stuff out of the stream. Anytime we pave they are careful of silt and stuff.

Reports from the Board - Mayor Bowman speaks to the issue of a speed device on Route 301 – Clerk reports on conversation with DOT. They support the installation of the signs as long as you move them around. Price estimates about \$5,000 for two signs. Discussion ensues about speeds in the Village.

Paving projects update – will get schedule in a week because the office was on vacation. Estimating the middle of September. We will be directing them to Park on Adams Avenue to practice winter parking.

AIRBNB - Trustee Winward explains that they will be preparing a survey for residents to fill out. Comparison of other laws that have passed. Will work on preparing the survey. Concerns are for safety, registration, and protection.

Spring St. parking - Secor speed- we were going to do no parking on both sides. Going to have Marc put signs up. The Sheriffs department will enforce the law. Discussion about Winter parking at the Masonic lodge also.

Discussion about speed on Secor St. coming through and exiting at Spring St. If we remove parking from the sides of the Street people can speed through more.

Speed bumps ? Take them up in the winter.

Resolution in honor of former Mayor Ed Cleary – Memorial resolution for former Mayor Ed Cleary. His daughter in law and son Jeff are online with us.
